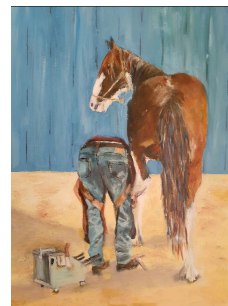
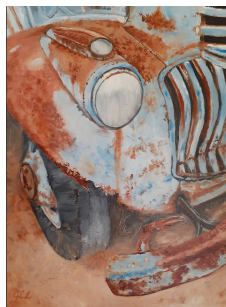
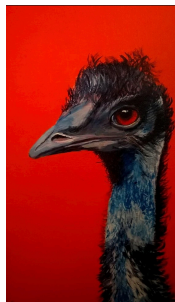
GLEN ROCK GALLERY
