President's Ponderings from Shirley Gregor

Hello Everyone,

SASI participation in the Esk Garden & Lifestyle Fair on 17 June went extremely well, after a chilly start setting up on a very cold morning. There were two SASI stalls with 12 artists from across the region contributing. Sales were good and were well distributed across the contributors. This was the first time where the majority of the work was 3D garden art. Members were inventive with 3D offerings including mosaic suncatcher hangings and sculptures, painted pots, painted fence art, decorative pots with moulded figures and animal gourd figures. It was also the first time that we had a Square terminal available to take sales using EFTPOS and 42% of sales was via Square. Manning the stall is a rewarding experience as you get to see people looking pleased and happy with the art they are buying.

Thanks to journalist Jacob Hayden from The Lockyer and Somerset Independent, who supplied the photos. Thanks are due also to friends and partners who helped with the putting up and taking down of the gazebos and to Lynette Hughes especially for helping with the receiving and distributing of the riches we earned.

Next month will be a busy one also, with Somerset Celebrates Art in July. More details are given further on in the newsletter.

A number of people have commented on how much they enjoy the Photography section in the newsletter from Phil Lister. Last month Phil talked about Artificial Intelligence in photography. People might also like to look at how you can use Al in other artwork. A free tool is Craiyon, available at https://www.craiyon.com/. I experimented with it to get ideas for different backgrounds and colouring schemes for a watercolour I was doing. It need to be used with care, as there is no acknowledgement of what images are used as a source for the work the Al produces and there is a risk of infringing copyright if the work is followed too closely. Al in art is something that could be investigated more.

The June exhibition in the Open Door Gallery will be of the work of the Hands on Learning students at the Lowood State High School.

Hands on Learning (HoL) is an innovative education program that caters to the different ways On Saturday 1st July, as the first event of Somerset Celebrates Art, the Lowood Open Door Gallery will present the Fernvale Artists Annual exhibition, followed on Sunday 2nd July by two excellent workshops.

The first, a pastel workshop teaching the basics of painting with pastels with Karen Leahy from 9.30am until 12.00noon, will be followed by a workshop on Scratch Art with Cassandra Hodgins from 1.00pm until 3.00pm. In Cassandra's two hour workshop you will learn the basic techniques of scratch art, where the black ink surface is removed from the substrate, to reveal the white clay underneath. Beautiful images can be created. All materials will be supplied for both workshops, and booking details are in the Somerset Celebrates Art brochure.

Following these, the next workshop will be on Sunday 6th August. 'Let's Make Art' will be a coloured pencil workshop presented by Marita Reynolds. See details in the flyer below.




