Robbie Greer - Rusticated Art

Meet Kiwi artist Robbie Greer, now settled in the scenic Lockyer Valley. His unique artistic technique involves creating intricate drawings using graphite before adding a defining touch with ink, a method he refers to as the "platinum finish."

In his upcoming exhibition, at Glen Rock Gallery in Esk, titled 'Bits of this and that,' Robbie will be presenting a captivating array of artworks. The collection encompasses a diverse range, featuring segments from his African series, as well as prints extracted from the collaborative book 'Beyond the Fence: In and around the Lockyer Valley,' researched and written by his partner Anna Hahn. The book focuses on his drawings of abandoned structures scattered throughout the Valley.

The exhibition will also include historical buildings found within the Laidley Pioneer Village. Notably, this showcase will also introduce never-before-seen material, adding a fresh and exciting dimension to Robbie's repertoire.



HEALING GARDEN | HIROMI TANGO 9 DEC 2023 - 18 FEB 2024

Healing Garden at The Condensery is a site-responsive project created with, for and by the Somerset community, in collaboration with internationally renowned Japanese-Australian artist Hiromi Tango.

Through a series of workshops, Tango, her artist educators and participants of all ages will co-create an immersive, sensory garden installation inspired by the healing properties of plants endemic to the local area, exemplifying art's capacity to transform, heal, strengthen, and support good mental health and wellness outcomes.

Hiromi Tango creates immersive, sculptural installations that invite audience interaction, often with a performative aspect. Driven by a passion for the therapeutic ability of art, Tango has worked with communities since 2009 to create spaces that encourage participants and audiences to slow down, unpack their thoughts and feelings, and lighten their spirits along the way.

REMNANTS | IMPRESSIONS | LOUIS LIM 9 DEC 2023 - 18 FEB 2024

Remnants | Impressions continues artist Louis Lim's interest in the diversity of the human condition, through non-fictional visual storytelling and conceptual photographic portraits. Remnants | Impressions consists of a series of framed photographs of reclaimed polaroid negatives found by the artist and laboriously brought back to life through a tedious process of bleaching, washing and drying.

As Lim tries to extract an image from the negatives he finds himself constructing stories to piece together any plausible recollection he might have. Like memories, these fragile photographic emulsions disintegrate while attempting to retrieve any evidence of the captured moment. What is left behind are the visual remnants and impressions for the viewer to fill in the gaps and create their own memories.

Lim's work has been exhibited across Australia and presented internationally. He was awarded the Queensland Festival of Photography Portrait Prize in 2012 and was shortlisted as a finalist in the 2017 Churchie National Emerging Art Prize, the 2016 Toowoomba Biennial Emerging Artist Award, the 2015 Josephine Ulrick and Win Schubert Photography Award, and the 2015 Head On Portrait Prize.

The Deb Mostert Everyday Sketchbooks project

About the project:

Everday Sketchbooks is a collaborative exhibition of work by Deb Mostert and the Somerset arts community. Artists and art groups in the Somerset region have been invited to participate in the Deb Mostert Everyday Sketchbooks workshops during February and March 2024. Workshop participants will be invited to contribute sketchbooks to the **Everday Sketchbooks** project which will then be exhibited at The Condensery.

About the workshops:

Everyday Sketchbook Workshops will explore the use of sketchbooks as an everyday record of a life observed. Together with Deb Mostert, local artists will explore recording their daily lives from the ordinary to the unusual to keep observant and present. They will experiment with hatching, watercolour washes and fun drawing exercises. With a simple kit of materials that can be carried, local Somerset artists can start a habit of drawing every day.

The workshop participants will explore the use of sketchbooks as an incubator, a sentimental keepsake, a mind clearer, a list holder, an idea launcher, a best friend, a personal, intimate, and honest playground. Sketchbooks are a creative space with no pressure to perform, a place to relax, to experiment, a window into our thoughts and dreams; a visible record of a life observed, to be thumbed back through in times of creative drought.
