Off the Hook - President's Report

Welcome SASI members and guests excited about the creative happenings in the Somerset region!

Reflecting back, July has been a busy month for yours truly with the Mackay Libris award and academic conference abbe 2025 on at the same time. It was an exciting event to be part of and was able to network with some wonderful Artist Book creators, listen to their stories and view their work.



The winner of the Libris award for 2025 went to Jude Taggart Roberts with her work titled "Less than 2 degrees". This is a frottage from a crop of fossilised coral from Ningaloo reef in Western Australia. The subject represents global warming and its catastrophic consequence for oceans and river systems everywhere. The work was brought back from the site and overprinted with a delicate metallic ink indicating numbers. It is then presented on a paper clay scroll with coral banner handles. Beautiful work!



We were treated to some interesting workshops. This one, presented by Clint Harvey, where we all printed a 'Kiss my Bot' on the moveable type presses was fabulous. The first print was printed from a laser printer of a robot in silver although a little hard to see in the image. Then we all inked the lettering and voila. This whole workshop is in a sea container complete with thousands of letters, some presses, ink from the day of poster printing and lots of knowledge to share and inspire. This Moveable Type Container is moved from centre to centre to share the older ways of printing on letterpress presses. Loved it.

Also, some exciting news from The Condensery! Our wonderful Regional Gallery is a finalist in the 2025 Museums and Galleries Qld, Gallery and Museum Achievement Award for Volatile Terrain, our inaugural Harvest Biennial. Absolutely well done, Madeline Brewer and team. Madeline has accepted a role with the Institute of Modern Art, starting in early August, which is a fantastic career move for her. We are sad to see her go and offer enormous thanks for the work she has done to establish The Condensery as a thriving contemporary gallery while including a much-loved local flavour.

Please welcome Denis Hawes to the SASI family of members. Denis joins the SASI Musos.

Small is Beautiful is a lovely high-quality exhibition. You still have time to cast your vote for the People's Choice until Tuesday 5th August and even buy a work or two. Artwork is to be collected at 9am on Thursday 7th August.





Mock Sun for an Inverted Daisy

19 July 2025 - 14 September 2025

Mock Sun for an Inverted Daisy is an installation by artist Tay Haggarty that uses the warmth of the sun as an entry-point for archiving queer and trans joy.

The artworks selected for display in The Condensery's bomb shelter form part of a larger series, titled Sun on Bare Back (SOBB), which were created prior to the artist receiving gender affirming care in 2023.

These abstracted works were initially developed to capture Tay Haggarty's daydream of hiking without a shirt, feeling the warmth of the sun on their back.

Now each work operates as a lighthouse when navigating the complexities of visibility. The golden artworks within Mock Sun for an Inverted Daisy function as a beacon of queer joy and a reminder that everyone deserves to feel comfortable in public spaces.

The Way Things Grow

19 July 2025 - 14 September 2025

Greenhouses and gardens are a way to escape time and place, offering a means for community building, creativity and experimentation amidst climate change. They are spaces where synthetic environments can be manufactured to protect, cultivate and propagate plants; spaces where both humans and other organisms can grow together; and, where we can improve knowledge in pursuit of a vibrant, well-fed and nourished planet.

The way things grow is an exhibition that considers greenhouses, gardens and backyards. Through displaying creative work, this exhibition uses the 'greenhouse' as a metaphor to propose new futures where socially-engaged, decolonial and eco-conscious practices are embraced.

This exhibition features new artworks created by Erika Scott, Gabriella Hirst, Jan Godfrey, Jane Nicholson, Libby Harward, Llewellyn Millhouse & Annie Bowman, Rachel King, and Susan McConnel.
